What is the cost?	<p>Dominion Energy customers participating in the Dominion Energy Green Power® VEPGA, COV, and Large Federal program in the 100% Option will be charged an additional \$5.95 for each megawatt-hour (MWh) of energy they use. Example: If your monthly energy usage is 10 MWh, the charge on your bill will be \$59.50 (\$5.95 x 10 MWh = \$59.50 added to your bill).</p> <p>Dominion Energy customers participating in the Dominion Energy Green Power VEPGA, COV, and Large Federal program in the Block Option will be charged \$2.00 for each 337 kWh block they elect to purchase. Blocks can be purchased in any increment of \$2.00, and customers can purchase as many blocks as they want. Example: If you elect to buy 10 blocks per month, the charge on your bill will be \$20 (10 blocks at \$2.00 = \$20 added to your bill).</p>
Will my rates change over time?	No, the rate will remain fixed. If the rate changes, we will notify customers in advance.
Contract Length	There is no contract. Your enrollment is month-to-month and can be cancelled or changed at any time. If you decide to cancel your participation, there will be no cancellation fee.
What other fees are there?	There are no additional fees associated with Dominion Energy Green Power.
What is a REC product?	Dominion Energy Green Power VEPGA, COV, and Large Federal program is a Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) product and does not contain electricity, which may be billed separately. A REC represents the environmental benefits of 1 megawatt hour (MWh) of renewable energy that can be paired with electricity.
