At Dominion Energy, we are committed to keeping you informed of upcoming work in your neighborhood. We want to provide an update on a project that will replace the fencing and enhance security measures at Arlington Substation located off South Four Mile Run Drive in Arlington, Virginia. This project is part of our Grid Transformation Plan which will help modernize the electric grid to meet the changing landscape of the energy industry.

Earlier this year, we communicated that the project would begin in spring 2024. However, delays to the project schedule have pushed the start time to fall 2024. We anticipate work to last through spring 2025.

During construction, you may see increased activity and traffic in the area. We do not anticipate any impacts to your electric service due to this work.
