Goose Creek 500 kV Substation Expansion Project

AT DOMINION ENERGY, we are committed to continually reviewing and analyzing our energy infrastructure to provide safe, reliable, and affordable electricity to the communities we serve. Northern Virginia, especially Loudoun County, is experiencing increasing energy demands which is driving the need for additional capacity in the electric transmission system to ensure reliability and resiliency for all customers. You are receiving this postcard because we are proposing to expand our Goose Creek 500 kilovolt (kV) Substation in Loudoun County, Virginia. This project will improve electric reliability for all customers in the area.


The substation's existing footprint will expand southward on Dominion Energy-owned property to accommodate new equipment. We recently filed our site plan application with Loudoun County. To review the plan, please visit the website, loudoun.gov. Pre-construction activities, including site preparation and vegetation management, are planned to begin in late 2022. Construction is scheduled to begin in early 2023 and end in December 2023, weather-permitting. The Goose Creek Substation Expansion Project is co-located with two other substations, including our Pleasant View Substation which is also planned to expand slightly in 2023 upon County approval.

The W&OD Trail is located northeast of our substation. Trail users will notice activity, but we do not anticipate any impacts to the trail as a result of this substation project. However, there is another electric transmission line project occurring in this area along the W&OD Trail. To learn about those impacts, visit DominionEnergy.com/Belmont.

Your electric service is not expected to be interrupted as a result of this project. We will continue to update you as activities progress. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to complete this important reliability project.
