the Ladysmith-Elmont 500 kilovolt (kV) Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project.

SCAN HERE TO LEARN MORE been in operation for more than five decades. The structures and conductor will be rebuilt to continue providing reliable electric service. No new right of way is required for this project.

The approximately 26.2-mile electric transmission

line spans Caroline and Hanover counties and has

Phase 1 of construction will rebuild approximately 7 miles of the electric transmission line with new galvanized steel lattice structures. Construction in this phase is expected to conclude in early 2025.

Construction on the remainder of the line will continue in Caroline County and move south towards Hanover County. Construction for all phases is expected to be complete in 2026.

We will continue to update you on the work as it progresses. Your electric service is not expected to be interrupted by this important project. Thank you for your understanding and patience as we work to ensure the continued safety and reliability of the electric grid.
