Loudoun - Ox 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Partial Rebuild Project

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to keeping the communities we serve informed of upcoming projects.

You are receiving this letter because work is scheduled to begin on the Loudoun-Ox 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Partial Rebuild Project. On June 2, 2020, the Virginia State Corporation Commission (SCC) issued its final order approving the rebuild of an 18-mile portion of the line between our Loudoun Substation in Dulles, Virginia and our Ox Substation near Springfield, Virginia. This project is necessary to maintain reliable service in your community.

This project will be completed in four phases. Beginning in mid-January 2022, you will see our crews in your area. These crews will build construction entrances and access roads to prepare for work along the right of way. The entrances will serve as the primary entrance and exit point for construction vehicles. Nearby residents may notice increased traffic, noise, and localized congestion while equipment is being moved to and from the site. We will do our best to limit any impact to your community.

After the project is complete, we will restore the site to its previous condition. The overall project is scheduled to be completed in December 2024. However, work on this phase, including restoration will be completed by June 2023.

As a reminder, due to the coronavirus, crews will be taking appropriate measures to protect the health and safety of our customers, communities and employees, including maintaining appropriate social distancing.
