Waller – Lightfoot – Skiffes Creek 230 kV Electric Transmission Line Rebuild Project

Dear Neighbor:

At Dominion Energy, we are committed to updating you about our projects in your community.

In June, we completed rebuilding approximately 13 miles of transmission line between our Lightfoot, Waller, and Skiffes Creek substations in Williamsburg, York County, and James City County, Virginia. The rebuild was constructed in the same right of way with new single-circuit and double-circuit weathering steel H-frame structures. This project improves electric reliability and resiliency for area residential and commercial customers.

Danger tree removal continues this summer between our Waller and Lightfoot substations. Danger trees are outside the right of way but have the potential to come within ten feet of the transmission wires or structures if they were to fall. Removing these trees is necessary to prevent power outages to large areas during major storms. We expect to complete forestry work in early fall.

Where both danger tree removal and construction are complete, we will remove access roads and wooden matting and will restore the right of way to its original condition. You may notice our crews or contractors in the right of way through winter monitoring the re-stabilization effort. Temporary silt fencing will remain until vegetation re-establishes. Please do not disturb rehabilitation areas.
